The Regis College School of Nursing and Health Professions is accepting applications for a new graduate program designed specifically for Radiologic Technologists (R.T.'s). The program is an accelerated graduate degree "Bridge" program whereby the RT with an associate degree engages in an accelerated upward mobility curriculum to earn a Masters of Science degree.

The program will be accepting students for January 2010.

The program currently offers two tracks; Health Administration and Health Product Regulation. A Third track in Advanced Clinical Practice to prepare students for certification as a Registered Radiologist Assistant (RRA) will begin fall 2011. The bridge program course work will include advanced level Radiologic Science courses and upper division track options in Computerized Tomography, Magnetic Resonance or Mammography Radiology.
